Service to Others: Further Information

Youth Ministry

Youth ministry is focused on providing a safe place for youth to learn about their faith, spiritually grow, and reach out in service to others. Whether it is attending youth events, volunteering as a Bible study leader, or being a confirmation mentor, volunteering in youth ministry invests in the bright young minds and hearts of our teens. If you have a heart for teenagers or want to invest in the next generation, youth ministry would be a great place to volunteer.

Children's Ministry

Children's ministry invests in the foundation of our faith by serving the youngest members of our church. Serving our children includes volunteering at VBS, helping with Sunday school, assisting at Club 45, and other opportunities. If you like telling Bible stories, playing games, or want to help support the spiritual growth as these young hearts encounter the love of Jesus for the first time, children's ministry is a great place to get involved.

Worship & Music

Sunday morning services have many places to serve in enhancing the worship experience through music and other means. You may want to join the worship planning team or participate in the choir, handbell choir or praise band. You could serve communion or help prepare the elements for communion Sundays. If you have musical abilities, enjoy planning, or want to be a part of creating worship experiences for others, worship and music is a great place to serve.

Missions

Our missions teams help lead in reaching out to our local community and to the world. Some ways to engage in missions include serving at the Dublin Food Pantry, One Dublin, Habitat for Humanity, or Meals on Wheels. Others could involve reaching out into new communities by being part of the Refugee Support team or Mission Guatemala. If God is calling you to reach out to serve others in our community and around the world, missions is a great place to invest your time.

Prayer/Care teams

Serving others can take on many forms. Being a part of the prayer and care teams involves supporting others from near and from afar. This includes joining the prayer chain, writing cards to those experiencing loss, being a part of our quilting ministry, driving people who cannot drive themselves, or being a spiritual presence for someone in need.
